1. Title
Guide for authorization of entities to perform fumigation as a phytosanitary measure under ISPM 45.

5. Scope
Entities performing fumigation as a phytosanitary measure. The guide should include responsibilities and actions of entities including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">– set the requirements that must be met by an entity to be authorized;– requirements for the training, equipment, competency and skills requirements for entities to perform phytosanitary actions;– specific performance criteria, guidelines and performance-based verification processes– for the actions performed by the entities for both stationary and in-transit fumigation.
6. Purpose
The guide should provide the fumigation efficacy criteria and help both NPPO and entities to outline limits of responsibilities while performing fumigation as phytosanitary measure.
7. Content for the IPPC Guide or training material
The proposed guide should provide; <ul style="list-style-type: none">- guidance for methods used for fumigation of bulk grains, toxicity of fumigants to target pests, etc;- make recommendations for fumigation of bulk grains for various temperature conditions;- describe the steps for fumigation procedure during storage and transportation considering similar target to be achieved, etc.
