Vineyard Establishment

- Choose sunny, well drained land
- Prepare soil with organic (mineral) fertilizers
- Use certified, healthy seedlings
- Install drip irrigation for efficient water management

Care and Plant Protection

- Regular irrigation and balanced fertilization
- Pruning to improve yield and fruit quality
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
- Prevent disease

Harvesting and Packing

- Harvest at full ripeness
- Select clean, undamaged clusters only
- Store grapes at 0 – 2° to preserve freshness
- Use standard packaging and accurate labeling
