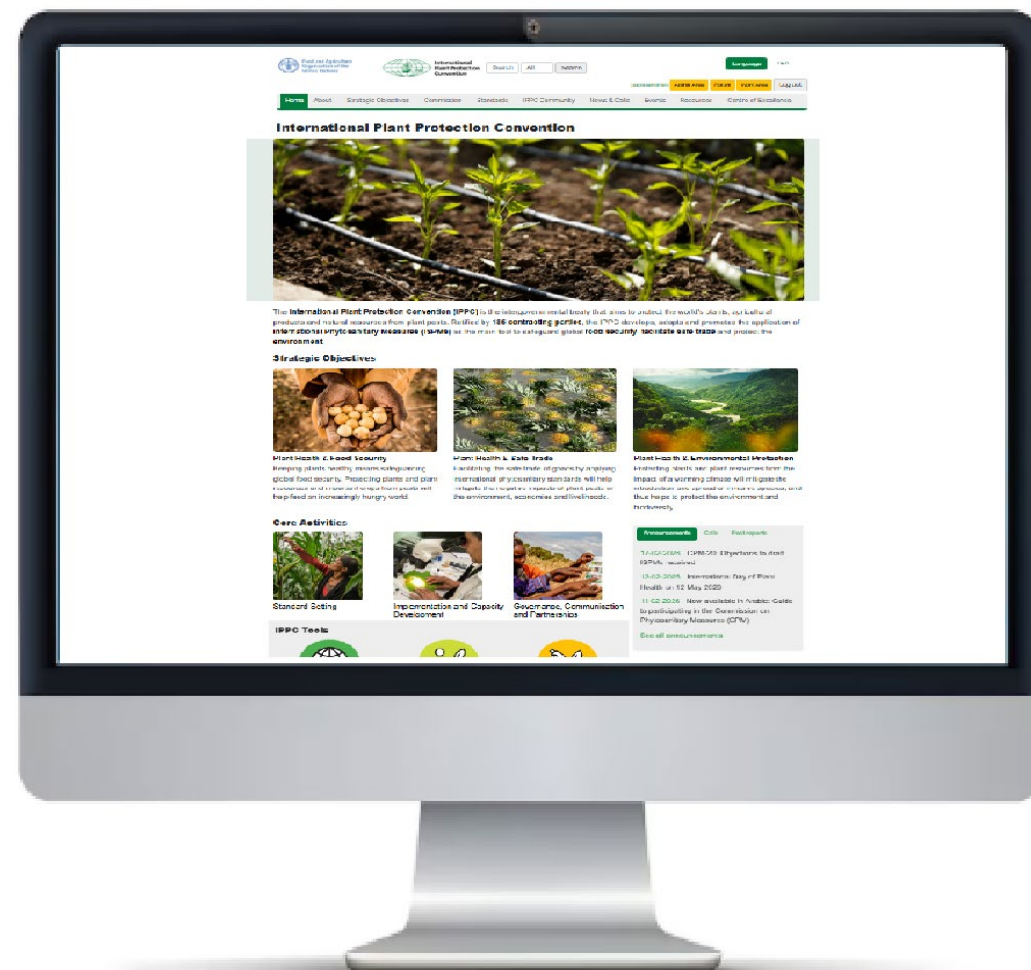

LOGIN

If you are a Country Contact Point you have an IPP account and can **login** to add/edit **National Reporting Obligations**.

In each Country page there are:

- a section with Contact details (you can edit your profile)
- a section with links to add/view your National Reporting obligations

As a Contracting Party of the IPPC you have some obligations, these are the **National Reporting Obligations (NROs)** that consist in reporting data as Description of the NPPO, Legislations, Entry Points, Pest Reports, etc.

In the main Countries page, you can find useful information as:

- Link to the full list of Official Contact Points, NROs
- On the right box: link to the Nomination form, NROs Guide

Please note that you can't change by yourself the Contact point of a Country. If a different person has been nominated as the NEW Contact point the NPPO need to sent to IPPC (ippc@fao.org) the **nomination form**, the form needs to be signed by the relevant person more senior than the new IPPC official contact point and should include the stamp of the National Plant Protection Organization or the institution it belong.
