

TPCS future steps

Commodity Standards are moving from concept to implementation. The next phase focuses on expanding the pipeline, strengthening participation, and supporting practical use.

The TPCS and IPPC work programme currently includes **seven topics related to commodity standards**, as approved by CPM-18 (2024).

Five of these topics have already been drafted and are planned for first or second consultation in July 2026, with their **adoption as annexes to ISPM 46 anticipated by 2028**.

Contracting Parties are encouraged to shape the next generation of Commodity Standards through:

☐ Submissions to the Call for Topics

Propose new commodity-specific standards or revisions to existing ones to address emerging risks, trade needs, and implementation challenges.

☐ Calls for information on specific commodity standards

Share technical data, national experiences, and practical insights to support the development of science-based and implementable commodity standards.

☐ Contribute to a more effective standard-setting programme

Active engagement helps ensure that commodity-specific ISPMs are relevant, practical, and supportive of safe trade and plant health protection.

Organisation of a Global Workshop on Commodity-Specific ISPMs in 2027

- ❖ Looking ahead, the IPPC Secretariat is exploring the organization of a **joint IPPC-APPPC Global Workshop on Commodity-Specific ISPMs, tentatively planned for June 2027.**
- ❖ Discussions are ongoing with the **APPPC, New Zealand**, and the **Republic of Korea** to identify opportunities for collaboration, leverage regional and global expertise, and expand engagement across the plant health community.
- ❖ The workshop is expected to **provide a platform to address emerging issues, strengthen understanding of the development and use of commodity standards**, and **raise global awareness of their role in supporting safe trade** and effective phytosanitary measures.
- ❖ Details of the proposal are available in the concept note submitted as **CPM 2026/CRP/02_rev1**.
